**Principal Report** (Karyn Bjelke-Petersen):

- Staff Absences – Thank you for the parents being very patient. Thank you to all our Teacher Aids supporting the teachers.
- Some of the Teacher Aides going on prac soon, so we will be trying to keep much stability for the students through this time.
- We have been inundated with new enrolments inquiries. This is giving us solid classes for our Preps for 2023.
- The new building has commenced this week.
- Every 5 years the school goes through an accreditation process which was completed back in 2019 for the years from P-Year 9. But as we have added Year 10, we will be going through this process again earlier than normal.
- Jazz in the Mall in Brisbane. Mrs. BP travelled with the Band down to Brisbane and there was such a positive response from the audience. The students should be very proud.
- Book Week costume day will be combined this year with Grandparents Day this year.
- Bushwhackers meeting was held here at the school. Other Lutheran Schools around Queensland (26) talking about different concerns and suggestions. This group meets twice a year.
- The Year 6 moving into Year 7 information night is being held 2nd August.
- Preparations for information for parents about year 10 students moving to year 11.
- August will have Prep Interviews.
- We are discussing with staff the timing of the PD week normally held in September with the future of year 12.
- Secondary year level – We will be incorporating looking at the timetable for staffing lunch breaks and when these grades are on lunch. Will look at operating these classes at different times to help minimise how many students are all out in the playground at the same time. We will be trying to plan ahead with incorporating next year what we will be continuing to operate with all year levels.
- Thank you to the P&F for the Ice blocks for Athletics day.

### **General Business:**

- We would like to clarify the Support for Students in the Wide Bay Sports also includes all other areas including the Arts and Cultural and Academic students. Ideas for presentation would be at the Assembly given by P&F and looking into different options for how to present the money to the families. Different options suggested would be cheque, cash, direct deposit, and Visa Card.
- School Disco proposed 9th September the theme will be Let it Glow. DJ Larry is available, and we will be using the Try booking again as this worked so well last time. Prep to Year 1 will need a parent. Through the Booking app, tickets will include a drink and sausage with options to purchase more. The year 6 students will be given the opportunity to sell Glow Sticks for the year 6 camp fundraising. Mrs. BP will give the hall keys closer to the date for early access.
- Ham Drive – Will be running the same in Term 4 this year as in previous years.
- Colour Run – Look at running the Colour run in week 9 Friday the 2nd of September starting around 5 pm. End of Year Celebration ending in a Family Dinner with music. Entry will be free for all students and Sausage Sizzle available for purchase for dinner. Caz will supply her sound system for the event. Will look at running at different times for different ages. There is also the suggestion for teachers to be included but with super soakers during the colour run.
- Looking at the Celebration of Learning. Conversations have started with Teachers with this event being held in Term 4 around week 4 or 5.
- Bookarama 2023 – A tentative Booking for the 24th to the 26th of March 2023. We will start collecting books in October.
- Year 6 Fundraising – Parents and Students run fundraising events throughout the year to help with the costs for their year 6 camp. This fundraising group is separate from the P&F. Some of the events have been Mother's Day and Father's Day stalls, Traffic Control at Burrandowan races,

Reeve girls making scrunchies, Eagleson Family had a Bull sale with a BBQ which they donated all sales from the BBQ, Chocolate Drive, and Glow Sticks. Thank you to everyone that has helped and contributed it has been very appreciated.
